The Vinyl Siding Institute (VSI) is the trade association for manufacturers of vinyl siding and suppliers of raw materials, equipment and services to the vinyl siding industry.

The purpose of VSI is to further the development and growth of the vinyl siding industry by:

- Opening new and maintaining current markets for vinyl siding through monitoring of building codes and the education of building code developers and regulators
- Developing material, product and performance standards
- Promoting acceptance and adoption of standards developed by VSI
- Addressing regulatory issues as they pertain to vinyl siding
- Sponsoring the VSI Vinyl Siding Certification Program



What is the Vinyl Siding Certification Program?

VSI developed the Vinyl Siding Certification Program to assure consumers---from homeowners and remodelers to architects and contractors---of the quality of the vinyl siding they select and use.

Certified vinyl siding is siding that is verified by an independent process to meet or exceed ASTM D3679---the long-standing, accepted industry standard for quality vinyl siding products. This process includes a series of rigorous tests, as well as periodic unannounced onsite inspections, to ensure compliance to standards such as durability during installation, resistance to weather conditions, and color retention.

Thanks to VSI's program, consumers also can be confident that they get what they pay for. Independent inspectors verify vinyl siding manufacturers' advertised specifications such as color, gloss, and dimensions.

The VSI certification label can be used only in connection with siding products that have successfully passed the standards of the Vinyl Siding Certification Program.
